AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ORLAND PARK VILLAGE CODE, TITLE 9, CHAPTER 9, SECTION 3. STOP INTERSECTION (MARLEY CREEK BOULEVARD AND TWIN LAKES DRIVE)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President of the Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park, Illinois.

SECTION 1

TRAFFIC TO STOP. All vehicular traffic moving in a easterly direction over, upon, or along Twin Lakes Drive shall come to a full and complete stop before entering the intersection of Marley Creek Boulevard and Twin Lakes Drive. All vehicular traffic moving in a westerly direction over, upon or along Twin Lakes Drive shall come to a full and complete stop before entering the intersection of Marley Creek Boulevard and Twin Lakes Drive. All vehicular traffic moving in a southerly direction over, upon or along Marley Creek Boulevard shall come to a full and complete stop before entering the intersection of Marley Creek Boulevard and Twin Lakes Drive, being intersecting streets within the Village of Orland Park, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois, except when directed to proceed by a Police Officer or except as otherwise provided by law.

SECTION 2

SIGNS TO BE ERECTED. Appropriate signs shall be placed at the intersections in Section 1 of this Ordinance to apprise the public that all vehicular traffic must come to a full and complete stop as set forth in Section 1 hereof.

SECTION 3

PENALTIES. Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not less than Seventy-Five (\$75.00) Dollars nor more than Seven Hundred and Fifty (\$750.00) Dollars for each offense of which such person shall be convicted.

SECTION 4

REPEAL. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions hereof are hereby repealed.
