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IDOT: Expect Delays on 159th Street from Ravinia Avenue West



ORLAND PARK, IL – Motorists traveling 159th Street from Ravinia Avenue to Will-Cook Road in Orland Park can expect delays.

IDOT's contractor will be making repairs to the utility trench crossings throughout the corridor requiring flaggers to move one lane of traffic through the work area. The contractor is installing a storm sewer pipe across 159th Street just west of 104th Avenue, also

requiring flaggers to move one lane of traffic through the work area.

Both ComEd and Nicor will continue to relocate facilities, energize lines and re-connect services in the corridor with an anticipated completion by the end of 2015. A T & T is continuing its underground work and relocation of services and expects completion by the end of the year.

Traffic will be shifted between 108th Avenue and Will-Cook Road the week of December 14, 2015. This will allow the construction of drainage utilities and permanent east bound pavement.

Train engineers are required to sound the train horns if workers are present near railroad tracks.

Portable message boards will be placed throughout the corridor alerting drivers of the construction activities and to expect delays. All scheduled work is highly weather dependent and may change daily.
