AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 9, CHAPTER 16 OF THE ORLAND PARK VILLAGE CODE IN REGARD TO THE AUTOMATED TRAFFIC LAW ENFORCEMENT AND ADMINISTRATIVE ADJUDICATION

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park (the “Village”) have the authority to adopt ordinances and to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs and protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1, the Village may pass all ordinances and make all rules and regulations proper or necessary, to carry into effect the powers granted to municipalities, with such fines or penalties as may deemed proper; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/1-2-1, the Village may retain attorneys and private collection agents for the purpose of collecting any default in payment of any fine or penalty or installment of that fine or penalty and may charge any fees or costs incurred by the Village with respect to retained attorneys or private collection agents to the offender; and

WHEREAS, the Village has established a system of administrative adjudication that provides for the collection of fines and penalties for automated traffic law enforcement violations, including any fine, penalty or part of any fine or penalty remaining unpaid; and

WHEREAS, the Village deems it to be in the best interest of the public to shift any fees and costs incurred by the Village with respect to attorneys or private collection agents retained for the purpose of collecting any default in payment of any fine or penalty or installment of that fine or penalty to the offender.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Orland Park, Cook and Will Counties, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1

The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth herein.

SECTION 2

Title 9, Chapter 16 of the Orland Park Village Code is amended by adding a provision to Section 9-16-14 thereto which shall read in its entirety as follows:

“9-16-14: PENALTY:
