## ITEMS FOR SEPARATE ACTION

### 2016-0861 Expedited Latent Print Examination - Purchase Approval

Police Chief Timothy McCarthy stated that latent print examination and Integrated Automated Fingerprint Identification System (IAFIS) confirmation performed by the Illinois State Police Crime Laboratory takes between 12 and 18 months due to the high backlog of cases. With the statute of limitations on misdemeanors being 18 months, the high wait time could result in the lack of prosecution even with identification of the offender. Additionally, waiting an extended period of time for laboratory results may place society at a further risk from a violent offender.

R.E. Walsh and Associates 1415 W. 22nd Street, Tower FL., Oak Brook , Illinois 60523, a corporation founded by three retired F.B.I. agents, provides a Illinois State Police vetted latent examination and IAFIS confirmation service with an average turnaround of between four and six hours upon submittal.

I move to recommend to the Village Board to approve the proposal from R.E. Walsh and Associates, 1415 W. 22nd Street, Tower FL, Oak Brook, Illinois 60523 for latent print examination at a cost of \$125.00 per hour with the maximum annual cost of \$5,000.00 funded through the Federal Asset Forfeiture account.

**2016-0868 Police Law Institute subscription to the Illinois Monthly Legal Update - Recommended Purchase**

Police Chief Timothy McCarthy reported that the Police Law Institute educates and empowers officers by providing superior online legal training. The primary goal is to keep our officers informed and safe. The legal training assists officers in effectively providing law enforcement services to our community while reducing the risk for civil litigation. Police Law Institute training is one avenue used to accomplish this goal.

The police department recommends the purchase of (99) 1 year subscriptions to the Illinois Monthly Legal Update and Review at a rate of \$128.00.

I move to recommend to the Village Board to approve the purchase of ninety nine (99) 1 year Police Law Institute subscriptions to the Illinois Monthly Legal Update and Review-440 Penn Ridge Dr, North Liberty, IA 52317-8054 at a cost not to exceed \$12,672.00.
