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**2<sup>nd</sup> RESIDENT NOTIFICATION OF CONSTRUCTION FOR THE FERNWAY  
SUBDIVISION ROADWAY AND DITCH GRADING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

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August 19, 2016

Dear Resident:

This is the second in a series of newsletters that will keep you informed about construction activities in the Fernway Subdivision. **Residents may park on any street during non-construction hours (7:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M.).**

***Impacted Streets***

-Robinhood Drive: From 167<sup>th</sup> Street to 171<sup>st</sup> Street

-167<sup>th</sup> Place: From 88<sup>th</sup> Avenue to East of Robinhood Drive.

Weather permitting, **construction activities will begin during the week of August 22, 2016.** Hopefully all personal property items have been removed from the right-of-way. The contractor will begin construction by replacing driveway culverts. If your driveway culvert is to be replaced, you will receive a green door hanger stating the date the work is scheduled. **On the scheduled day your driveway will not be accessible.** If you will need your vehicle during this day, please relocate it before 7:00 A.M. to the south side of the street or any of the designated parking areas shown on the attached exhibit. Your driveway access will be restored by the end of the work day.

In early September, once all culvert construction is complete, the contractor will begin excavating the roadway. This may be the second time you will not be able to use your driveway. Similar to the culvert work, you will receive a green door hanger a day or two prior to the scheduled work. If you need to access your vehicle during 7:00 A.M. to 7:00 PM, please make sure to relocate your vehicle before 7:00 A.M. to one of the designated parking areas. Again, your driveway access will be restored by the end of the work day.

After the roadway has been excavated, concrete ribbon curb will be constructed. This may be the third time you will not have use of your driveway. Once again, you will receive a door hanger prior to construction of ribbon curb. This door hanger will be orange. **In order to properly cure the concrete, you will not be able to drive your vehicle across the new curb for several days.** Please park your vehicles in one of the designated parking areas during this time. Your driveway access will be restored within one week of the curb construction.


As you may have noticed on the attached exhibit, handicap parking areas are located at two different locations. The requirements to use these temporary parking areas are the same as they would for any other posted handicap parking. Finally, garbage pickup will be earlier than usual during this construction project. Please have all receptacles staged by 6:00 A.M. on garbage day.
